Dr. Dale Chapman received his Doctorate in Administration, Planning Social Policy from Harvard University in 1986. He earned a Masters Degree from Michigan State University and his undergraduate degree from the University of Kentucky. Dr. Chapman's career in higher education spans over three decades.

Dr. Chapman has served at Lewis and Clark Community College since 1988 and has been President since 1992. Lewis and Clark is a comprehensive community college enrolling 7,400 credit students and approximately 12,000 total students with an annual operating budget in

excess of \$17.6M and a capital budget of \$22M. Prior to Lewis and Clark, Dr. Chapman's professional career included administrative positions with the College Board; the American Council on Education; Education. Commission of the States; Harvard University; Suomi College; Kentucky Council on Higher Education; University of Kentucky; and Jefferson Community College. He has authored and coauthored numerous articles, publications, grants and contracts.
